Financial Technology, or FinTech, is a fast-growing area focused on simplifying, improving and automating the delivery of financial services. To help prepare you for the future of finance, we're offering a new Certificate in FinTech and a new Minor in FinTech.¹

SEQUENCE OF COURSES FOR CERTIFICATE

1. First semester (Fall 2021): Take **FIN 3403H** Business Finance² and **ECO 4444** Intro to Business Analytics for FinTech.
Note: B or better in FIN 3403H required to qualify for program.
2. Second semester (Spring 2022): Take **FIN 4450** Foundations of FinTech³.
3. Third semester (Fall 2022): Take **FIN 4451** FinTech for Decision Makers⁴.

REQUIREMENTS FOR MINOR

1. Successfully complete the Certificate requirements.
2. In addition to the requirements for the FinTech Certificate, you can get a Minor in FinTech with the first two computer science courses (COP 3223C or EGN 3211 and COP 3502).³

New Minor & Certificate: Open to Accounting, Economics & Finance Majors

We believe that the FinTech Certificate or the Minor in FinTech will broaden your options and make you a more competitive candidate in the job market.

Notably, this is the first such program of its kind in the State of Florida and among the first in the country.
