A Minor is a complement to a bachelor's degree program/major requiring at least 18 credit hours in a field. A student may declare a Minor at any point during the first term of enrollment but no later than the submission of the "Intent to Graduate" form. Students are strongly urged to declare a Minor as early as possible. Minors are optional unless required by your specific major. All graduation requirements (i.e., the Minor and Major), must be from a single UCF Undergraduate catalog for which a student is eligible. Note: Some Minors impose specific admissions requirements. Minors may not be effective for all catalog years.

An undergraduate Certificate is a supplement to the bachelor's degree program/major. A student may declare a Certificate at any point during the first term of enrollment but no later than the submission of the "Intent to Graduate" form. Students are strongly urged to declare a Certificate as early as possible. Effective Summer 2005, students may receive an undergraduate Certificate by completing all requirements for an undergraduate Certificate program. Students must be admitted in a degree seeking program to be eligible to receive an undergraduate Certificate. Certificate programs may not be taken independently of a degree program. All graduation requirements (i.e. the Certificate and Major/Minor) must be from the same UCF Undergraduate Catalog for which a student is eligible.
