


Sourcing Recruiters, Contacts & Alumni on LinkedIn


Use these steps to network after applying for positions and/or when you are looking for mentorship and guidance from an expert in your field.

Connect with Recruiters & Other Contacts




Step 1: The Company.

Login to your LinkedIn account and type in the desired company name in the search bar. Click on the company name to redirect to company page.



Step 2: The People.


Next, choose the "People" tab from the menu bar on the company profile page.



Step 3: The Recruiter.


Type "Recruiter" in the search bar below the menu bar shown in Step 2. Click enter on your keyboard. All Recruiters at the company will populate. *You can do this for ANY job title.*

Connect with UCF Alumni




Step 1: Your University.

Login to your LinkedIn account and type in "University of Central Florida" in the search bar. Click the university name to redirect to profile page.



Step 2: Your Alumni.

Next, choose the "Alumni" tab from the menu bar on the university profile page.



Step 3: Your Mentor.

Type in your desired company name in the search bar below the menu bar shown in Step 2. All employees from that company that are also UCF alumni will populate. *Continue to add search tags based on job title, location, etc. to find the best match.*
