# MAJOR INTERNSHIP REQUIREMENTS



## **Accounting**

- Ability to complete a minimum of 200 hours during the chosen semester (Spring, Summer, Fall)
- 3.0 UCF GPA
- Have completed ACG 3141: Intermediate Accounting II with a C or better

### **Finance**

- Ability to complete a minimum of 300 hours during the chosen semester (Spring, Summer, Fall)
- 2.75 UCF GPA
- 3.0 Major GPA
- Have completed 1 major related course beyond FIN 3403: Business Finance with a B or better

## Management

- Ability to complete a minimum of **200** hours during the chosen semester (Spring, Summer, Fall)
- 2.75 UCF GPA
- Have completed MAN 3025: Management of Organizations

## **Marketing**

- Ability to complete a minimum of 200 hours during the chosen semester (Spring, Summer, Fall)
- 2.75 UCF GPA
- Have competed 1 major related course beyond MAR 3023: Marketing

## **Integrated Business**

- Ability to complete a minimum of 200 hours during the chosen semester (Spring, Summer, Fall)
- 2.75 UCF GPA
- Have competed 1 major related course beyond the Primary Core

### **Economics**

\*Can only be used toward your 120 credit hour req.

\*Will not satisfy and ECO req.

- Ability to complete a minimum of 200 hours during the chosen semester (Spring, Summer, Fall)
- 2.75 UCF GPA
- Have taken 1 major related course beyond QMB 3200: Quantitative Business Tools II

### Real Estate

- Ability to complete a minimum of 300 hours during the chosen semester (Spring, Summer, Fall)
- 2.75 UCF GPA
- 2.75 Major GPA
- Have competed 1 major related course beyond REE 3043: Fundamentals of Real Estate with a B or better
