Richard Lapchick, Ph.D., Eminent Scholar & Endowed Chair, DeVos Sport Business Management, recently stepped down from his role as director of the DeVos program 20 years after founding the program that brought national and global recognition to UCF and the College of Business. SportBusiness International has named the DeVos program as one of the top 10 graduate level degree sport business programs in the world, and over the years, the program was recognized as one of the top five in America by the *Wall Street Journal*, *The New York Times*, *ESPN The Magazine* and *Forbes*

Magazine. Lapchick, a prominent human rights activist, pioneer for racial equality and internationally recognized expert on sports issues, was named the Muhammad Ali Humanitarian of the Year by the Muhammad Ali Center.

Glenn A. Dial, '88, Senior Retirement Strategist of American Century Investments and former Head of the U.S. Retirement Business at Allianz Global Investors, and prior to that, National Sales Manager of the DCIO Business at JP Morgan Asset Management. He holds two patents as the co-inventor of the “method and system for evaluating target-date funds.” A nationally known speaker in the retirement plan industry, he is one of the Most Influential People in the 401k industry, according to the 401kWire.com. Dial is a member of the Dean’s Advisory Board for the College of Business and was a keynote speaker at UCF graduation in December. He has a bachelor’s in finance from UCF and an MBA from Rollins College.

Inez J. Long, '98 MBA, is President/CEO of Black Business Investment Fund (BBIF) and has 35 years of combined experience in the financial services industry. In 2020, she was awarded the Ned Gramlich Lifetime Achievement Award for Responsible Finance. BBIF is a not-for-profit, Community Development Financial Institution (CDFI) that focuses on providing capital to Black, minority and underserved small businesses. This year marks Long's 30th year of service to BBIF; under her leadership the organization has provided more than \$70 million in loans to more than 400 businesses, impacting over 14,500 jobs. In

2020, she was awarded the Ned Gramlich Lifetime Achievement Award for Responsible Finance, the CDFI industry's highest honor - the first black woman to receive this recognition. Long serves on the national boards of the Association for Enterprise Opportunity, African American Alliance of CDFI CEOs, Expanding Black Business Credit and the National Community Advisory Board for Fifth Third Bank. She has an MBA from UCF and a bachelor's in accounting from the University of South Florida.

Barry Miller, '95, is a co-founder, board member and President of Voloridge Investment Management, a \$9 billion hedge fund firm in Jupiter, Fla. He is responsible for overseeing all operational areas of the firm and strategic planning. Prior to Voloridge, he served as CEO of LASAS Technologies, a finance and insurance company he co-founded in 1998. This company controlled about 10 percent of all U.S. sales within its applicable market and in 2009 was sold to Golden Gate Capital, a \$12 billion private equity group. His background includes financial analysis, capital raising, financial markets, actuarial experience, software development, as well as in-depth company infrastructure formation. He graduated with honors from UCF with a bachelor's in finance. He remains involved with his alma mater speaking to business students in *The EXCHANGE* and through participation on different committees and work-groups. Beyond UCF, Miller is actively involved in community outreach directly and through his company's philanthropic pursuits.




