



EXECUTIVE MBA INTERNATIONAL RESIDENCY

Practical lessons in global business.

The Executive MBA includes a required international residency in conjunction with the program's International Business Analysis course (GEB 6365). This dedicated travel week enhances our student's exposure to global business and provides students with the opportunity to apply concepts learned in the classroom to a real-world international setting.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Required Course

The International Business Analysis (GEB 6365) is a required EMBA course and provides students with extensive coverage of international business environments with emphasis on the functional operation of multinational firms.

Global Experience

The EMBA International Residency is a required week-long intensive global immersion program designed to provide students with experience working in an international business setting. Students apply lessons from their international business course to roundtable discussions, formal presentations and company site visits with executives from diverse industries and organizations. Cultural events and site exploration are included to provide a full international immersion experience.

DURATION

Week-long international travel during the fourth term (Fall 2) of the EMBA program.

COST
