Mark L. Plaumann '74 '79 MBA is the Managing Member of Greyhawke Capital Advisors, which he co-founded in 1998. The two-time Knight, who was inducted into the College of Business Hall of Fame in 2008, was an academic superstar as a student, finishing a two-year college degree while still in high school and earning his bachelor's degree after just one year at UCF, then FTU. He went on to earn his MBA. He and his wife, Marilyn E. Wilson, have

given back to the university for more than 30 years — supporting a wide range of initiatives, many with a focus on College of Business programs like Investors in Entrepreneurship and the Center for Entrepreneurial Leadership. In 2021, the couple donated \$1 million to an endowed scholarship fund for first-generation college students. He also serves on the UCF Foundation Board and the Dean's Advisory Board for the College of Business.




